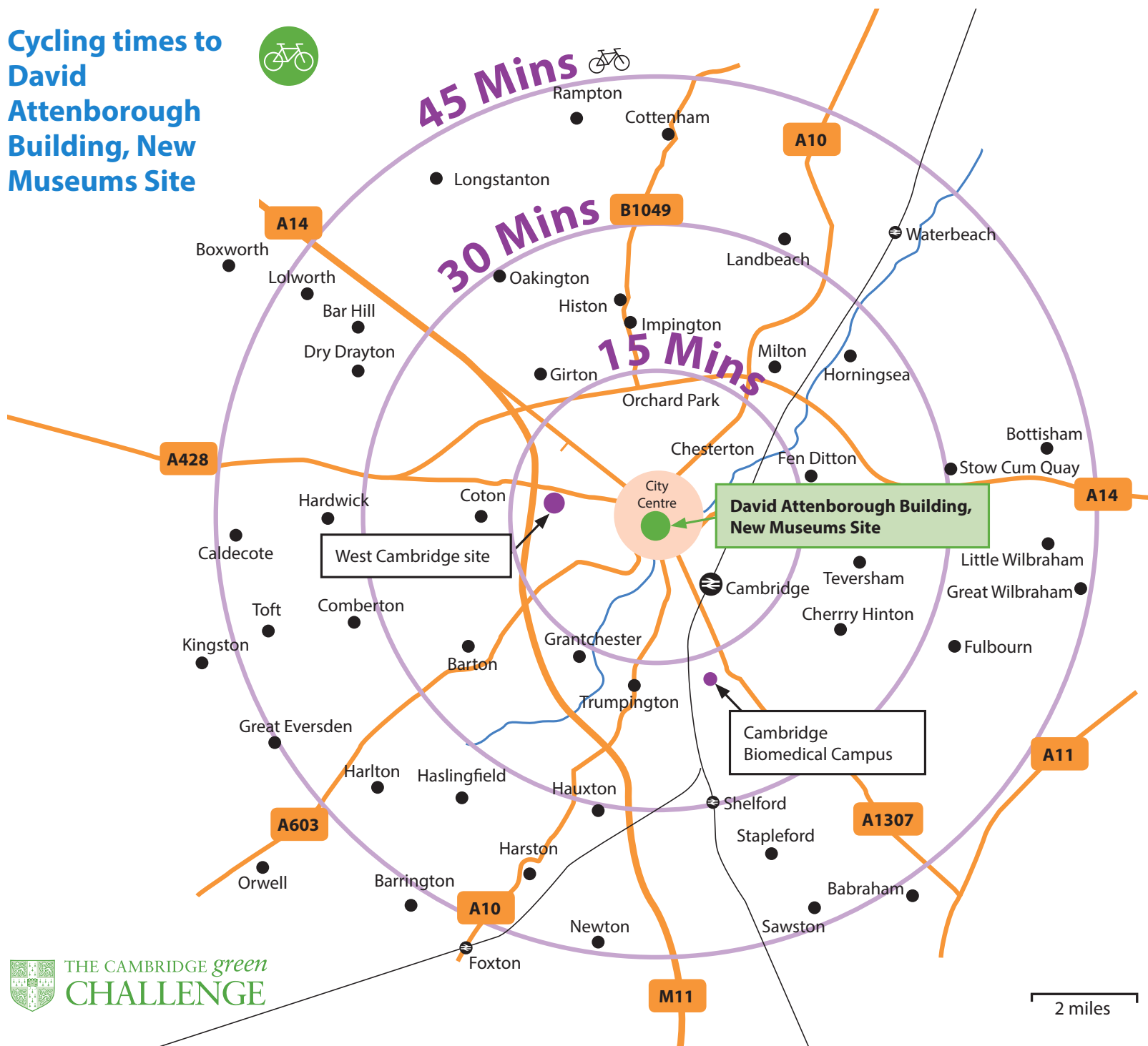




Cycling times to David Attenborough Building, New Museums Site



Cycle

In Cambridge it's quicker to make many journeys by cycling than by car.

The map shows typical cycling time to get to the David Attenborough Building based on someone cycling at a moderate speed of 10km per hour.

This shows you can easily get to the train station and many other University sites in less than 15 minutes by bike.
