2. Complete Sender's Details Label, writing clearly in Block Letters.
3. Cut out and fix the Reply Paid Label and the Sender's Details Label onto a sturdy bag with glue or sticky tape.
4. Place up to 4 phones in the bag, seal it and post it at any Street Post Box or at any Australia Post Outlet. **THERE IS NO POSTAGE TO PAY**

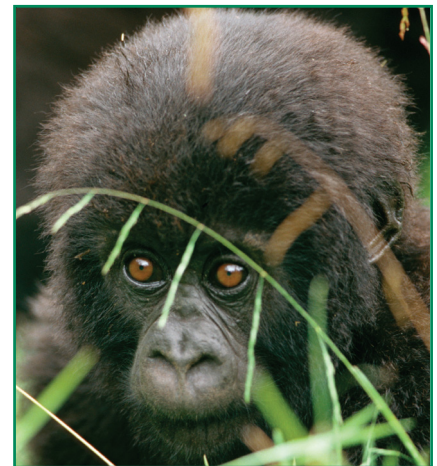
