### Fauna & Flora

At Fauna & Flora, our shared purpose is to protect the diversity of life on Earth, for the survival of the planet and its people. We work closely with local conservation partners around the world to save nature, together. We harness this collective expertise to inspire positive change globally.

### **Climate & Nature Linkages Team**

The Climate and Nature Linkages (CNL) team support Fauna & Flora project teams and partners (including NGOs, governments, communities and corporates) to use high quality and locally appropriate Nature-based Solutions (NbS) to climate change that create measurable benefits for nature, climate and people.. To achieve this, the CNL team works to support our projects to integrate climate change mitigation and locally-led, ecosystem-based adaptation approaches within conservation design and implementation, and to access climate finance.

With a sub-set of projects and partners, the team supports the development of market-based NbS projects, designed to generate sustainable finance for locally-led conservation through participation in the voluntary carbon market, or the nascent biodiversity credits market. Alongside this project development role, the team invests significant technical capacity in engaging to influence the wider development of these markets, advocating for high integrity on both the supply and demand side. In the context of nature-based carbon projects and the use of nature-based carbon credits, our position is articulated in <a href="Fauna & Flora's Position on High Integrity Nature-Based Carbon Markets">Flora's Position on High Integrity Nature-Based Carbon Markets</a>.

## The Opportunity

This role will serve as technical lead for the continued development and expansion of Fauna and Flora's portfolio of REDD+ projects in priority landscapes. You will play a key role in linking these unique forest landscapes, their biodiversity, and the Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities on the frontline of conserving them, with sustainable and equitable climate finance. The voluntary carbon market, and nature-based approaches including REDD+, are emerging from a period of intense scrutiny and evolution. At this time of change, opportunity and increasing need, Fauna & Flora is seeking an experienced and dynamic individual to support selected regional projects and partners to establish high-quality REDD+ initiatives that effectively protect and restore forest carbon stocks and biodiversity, and empower and benefit the stewards of the land.

You will have a cutting-edge understanding of the technical requirements for high quality REDD+ projects, including robust knowledge of forest carbon accounting and REDD+ standards and methodologies, a commitment to nature-based climate solutions that place people and nature at their core, and an ability to work swiftly but highly collaboratively to advance the development of projects. You will have excellent leadership, people management and communication skills; and the ability to combine your senior technical expertise with sound judgement to navigate complex situations.

You will hold a relevant higher degree or equivalent qualification and/or professional experience in the design and implementation of REDD+ projects and nested initiatives. You will be joining Fauna & Flora at an exciting time as expand our focus on climate change, the critical role of nature for climate mitigation and adaptation, and the role of climate finance in scaling up investment in

nature. The role offers the opportunity to work within an international, impactful and ground-breaking organisation, at the forefront of global conservation.

#### Purpose:

The Senior Adviser, REDD+, is the senior technical lead for the development for Fauna & Flora's REDD+ programme. The role is responsible for overseeing REDD+ project development and implementation; providing technical expertise in latest REDD+ methodologies and developments to ensure the integrity of technical decision-making at all stages of the project cycle; and driving the strategic development of the REDD+ programme of work.

As a senior member of the team, they will help Fauna & Fauna build its organisational profile in the nature-based carbon markets and identify and develop strategic external partnerships that can further support the effective implementation of REDD+ by project teams and partners.

Initial priority geographies are likely to include landscapes in Liberia, Guinea, DRC and Cambodia.

#### **Specific Duties:**

#### **Programme Development & Implementation:**

- Oversee and support the execution of REDD+ feasibility and pre-feasibility assessments, including identification of, and collaboration with, required consultants to complement Fauna & Flora and partner responsibilities;
- Oversee and support the full development of REDD+ projects, ensuring high integrity of REDD+ design and implementation to maximise climate, biodiversity and community benefits. and working to ensure project teams have the skills, capacity and resources required to deliver robust, high-quality projects;
- Oversee and support the development of technical project documentation, including Project Documents and MRV reports and work with project teams on preparation for third party validation and verification audits;
- Ensure all feasibility and development stage projects are underpinned by a robust financial model, working effectively with relevant specialists and project staff to ensure data and assumptions are fit for purpose and effectively present the balance of project risk and opportunity.
- Coordinate with regional teams, to engage with geographically relevant national governments, partners, and other stakeholders to develop and strengthen governance structures and frameworks to enable REDD+ implementation.

#### **Technical Advisory:**

- Serve as senior technical lead for REDD+ and related methodologies, including Verra and Plan Vivo, and advise on technical and strategic aspects of REDD+ program design, implementation, and monitoring.
- Maintain a cutting edge and comprehensive understanding of latest technical developments in REDD+, methodologies, standards and international, national and sub-national policy developments relevant to nature-based carbon markets, and REDD+ in particular;
- Apply technical expertise in carbon accounting and nature-based carbon project development to investigate potential project opportunities under REDD+, with potential to also explore ARR approaches in future.
- Working closely with relevant specialists and partners, lead efforts to proactively advise on and integrate new technologies and tools to strengthen REDD+ development and implementation such as accuracy of carbon accounting and project MRV, and transparency and efficiency of benefit-sharing;
- Ensure key information is disseminated effectively and that these developments are appropriately integrated into Fauna & Flora and partner practice.

#### **Strategic Development:**

- Oversee and support the strategic planning and development of the REDD+ programme, ensuring alignment with Fauna & Flora's organisational wide strategy
- Work closely with the other senior leads, to develop and manage strategic external
  partnerships and work with the private sector, to enable growth of Fauna & Flora's portfolio of
  REDD+ projects and nature-based carbon projects more broadly;
- Play a leading role in development of funding opportunities to progress REDD+ implementation both at the Fauna & Flora portfolio (multi-site) and project (site specific) levels, in close collaboration with relevant regional teams and cross-cutting specialists;
- Support the CNL senior team, to advise Senior Leadership Team (SLT) on strategic and technical REDD+, development opportunities and risks, including through active participation in the Fauna & Flora Leadership Forum.

#### **Management & Capacity Development:**

- Provide supervision and effective line management and matrix management of REDD+ specialist roles, ensuring close integration of REDD+ technical staff and approaches with regional programme staff and practice;
- Line-manage designated staff through clear objective setting, continuous performance management, annual appraisal, training provision and personal development planning to ensure the effective and timely delivery of programmes of work and develop individuals and their functions
- Lead efforts to ensure project and partners teams have the skills, capacity and resources required to deliver robust, high-quality REDD+ projects;
- Support sound financial and operational management of the CNL programme in full compliance with FFI policies and procedures

#### **Communication and Representation:**

 Working with CNL and other relevant teams, coordinate representation of Fauna & Flora in relevant policy dialogues with a view to influencing positively policies and investments in REDD+.

- Develop internal and external communications to strengthen the profile of Fauna & Flora's work on REDD+ and elevate examples and evidence of impact emerging from Fauna & Flora projects and partners.
- Represent Fauna & Flora's REDD+ work to internal and external stakeholders, including
  government agencies, NGOs, for-profit entities, academic institutions, funders, donors and
  media, and relevant networks/ working groups, proactively developing its profile and presenting
  and promoting its work and approach with confidence and credibility.
- With agreement of line manager, perform other tasks that may be requested from time to time
